We are also excited to announce the completion of the basketball court refurbishment project. It was spearheaded by Mark Pound, Trustee. A Community Recreation Capital Grant was secured through the Department of Communities, Culture, Tourism and Heritage in the amount of \$2,261.67. The church also received \$3000 from the Mud Creek Rotary Club. The 2024/25 Councillor Grants to Organizations Program Award through the Municipality of the County of Kings approved \$1050. The Coldbrook & District Lions Club contributed \$250. Canadian Tire in New Minas donated tremclad paint, wire brushes, and a new basketball net totaling \$113.97. Michael Parker and Vernon Wells removed the dirt pile in preparation for paving. Thank you to all these individuals and organizations for their support in this project. The children and youth were super excited to use it at our Christmas gathering, despite the cool weather. The Church is thankful to Bowlby Paving for paving a 20' x 20' pad, which will be used for multiple sports.
